Winder Water System Customers:

The annual Water System Flushing Program for the City of Winder will begin May 1st, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

This program is designed to flush and remove any sediment deposits from our system's water mains, in addition to improving water quality and flow characteristics of our infrastructure.

During the flushing process, you may experience temporary discoloration of water and/or a temporary drop in pressure; however, this should only last a few minutes. This discolored water does not present a health hazard and if the discoloration persists for longer than 2 or 3 minutes feel free to contact our office at the numbers listed below.

There are a few recommended precautions you may wish to take at the time while we are in your area:

- 1.) Limit your laundering to after 5:00 pm, if possible
- 2.) Before using, run your cold water faucet 2 to 3 minutes until clear

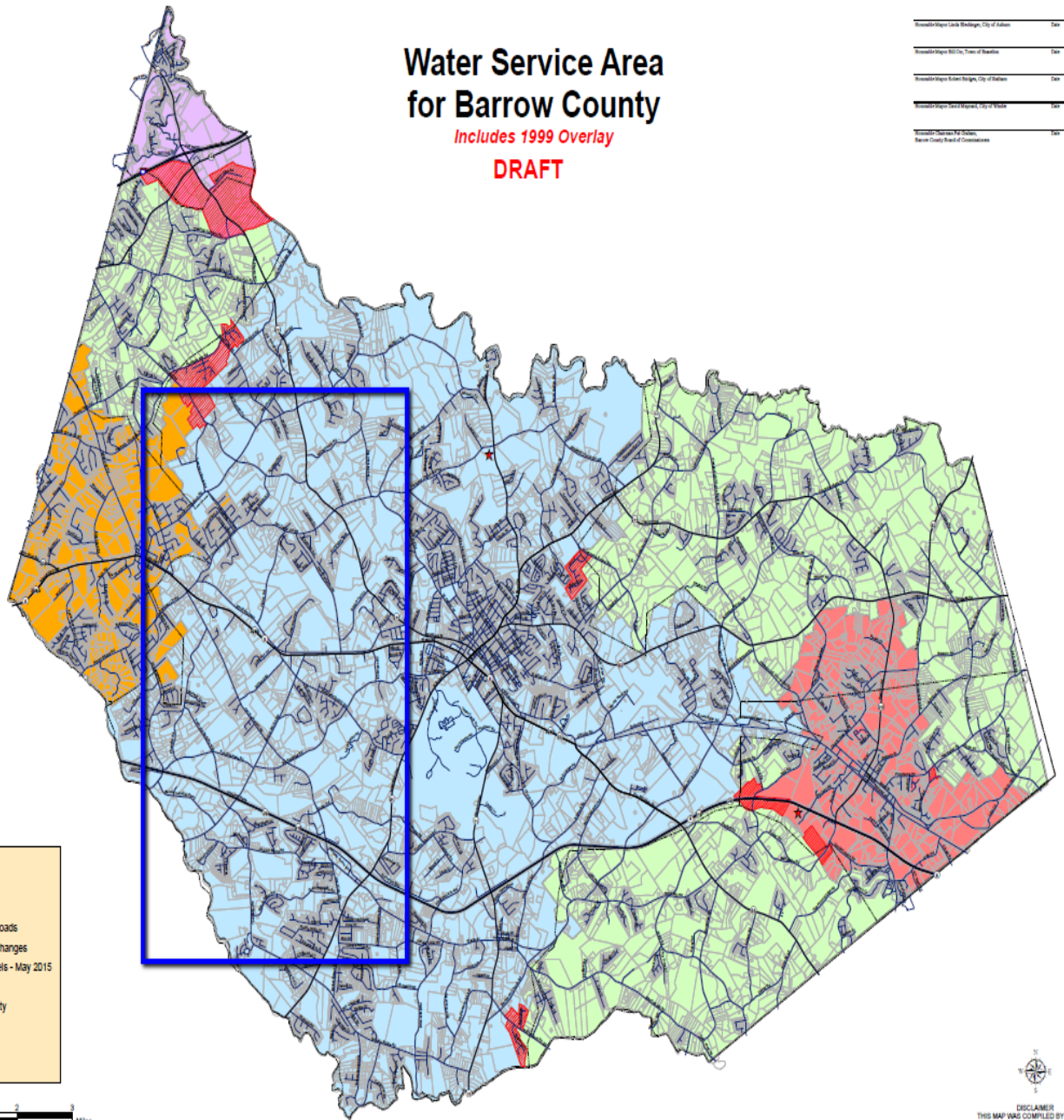
