

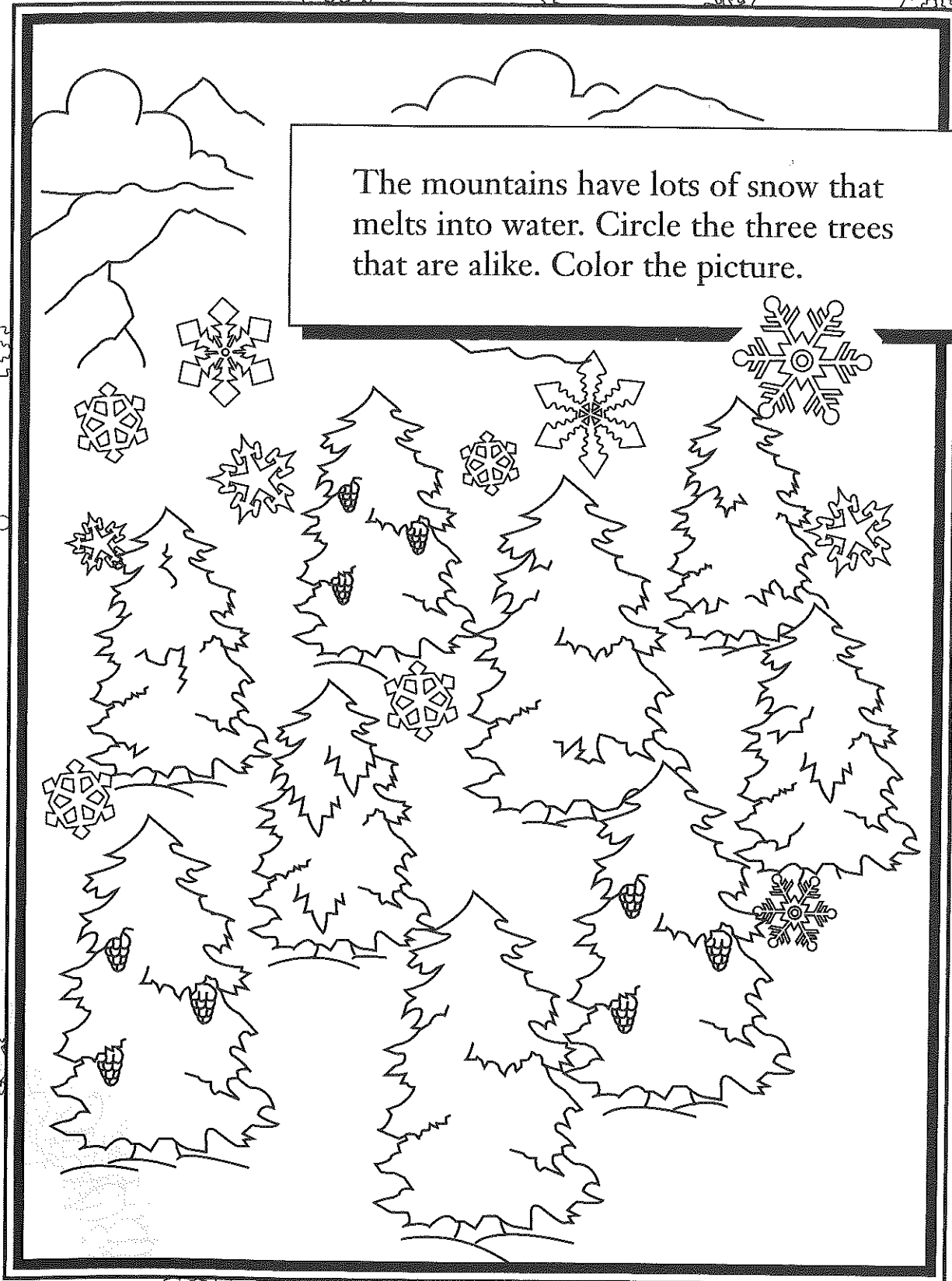




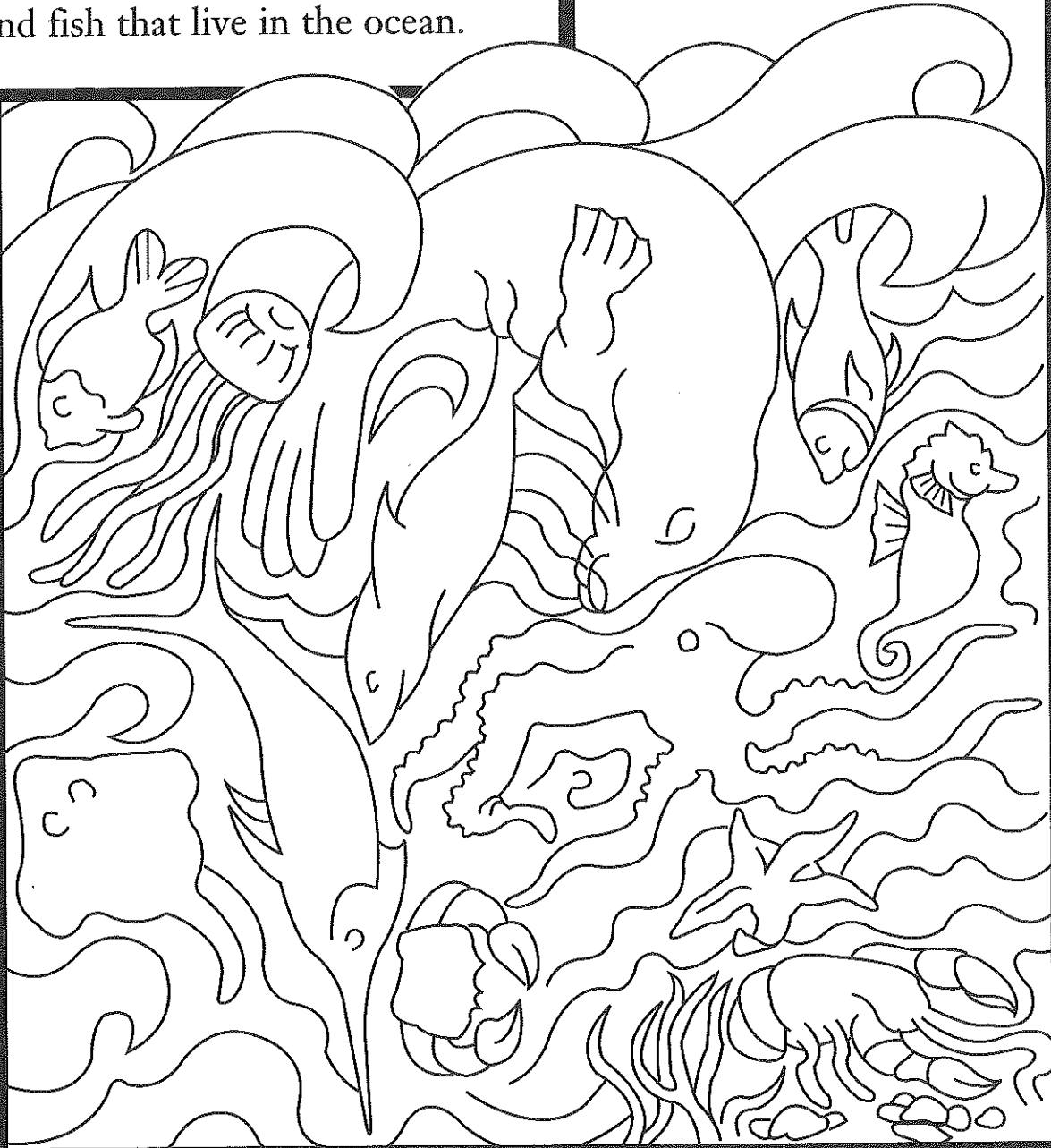
You can't see it, but water is always moving in the air to form clouds. Then it falls back down as rain or snow.

The plants and animals that live there need very little water.

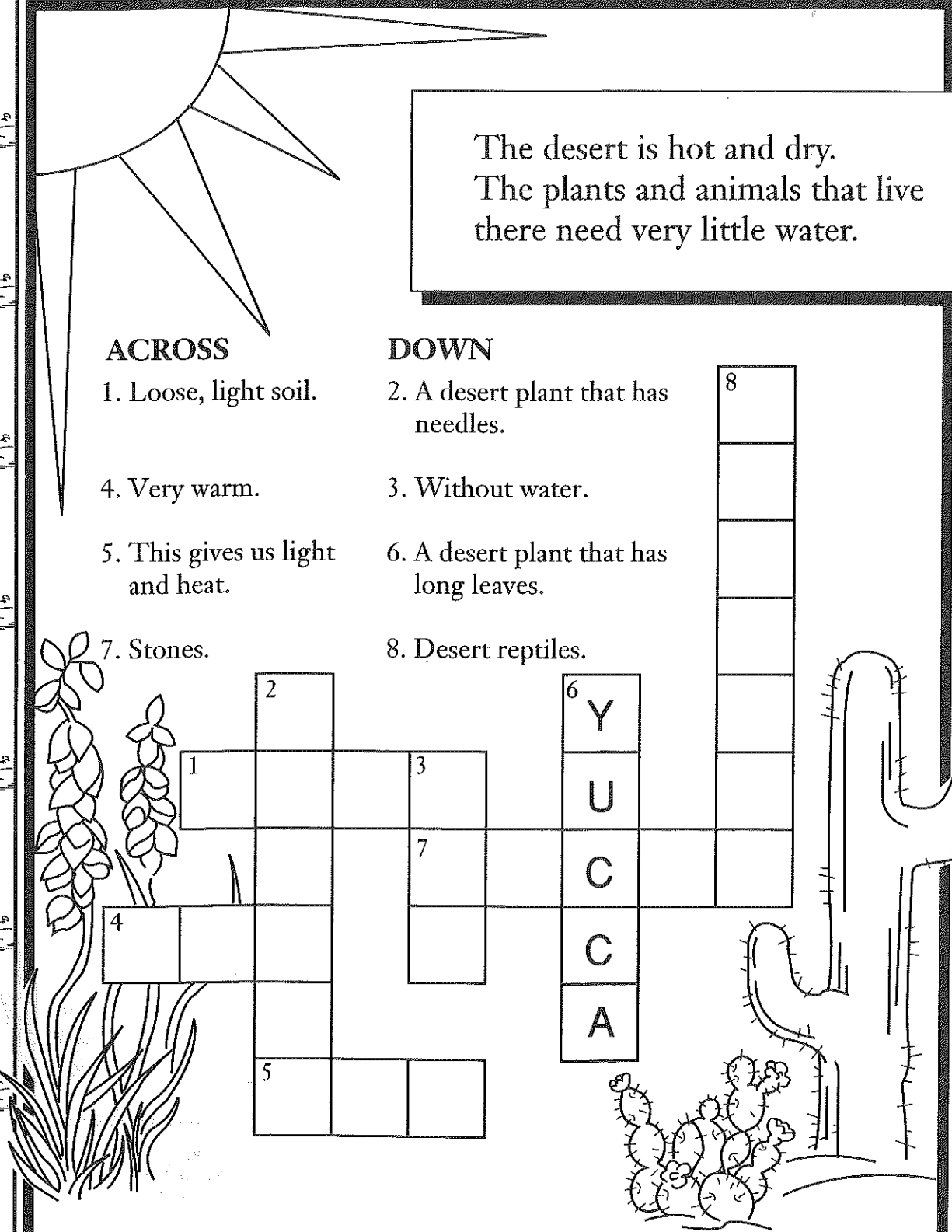

Water gets dirty, so before we can drink it, we must clean it. Water is cleaned in a treatment plant and sent to everybody ready to use.

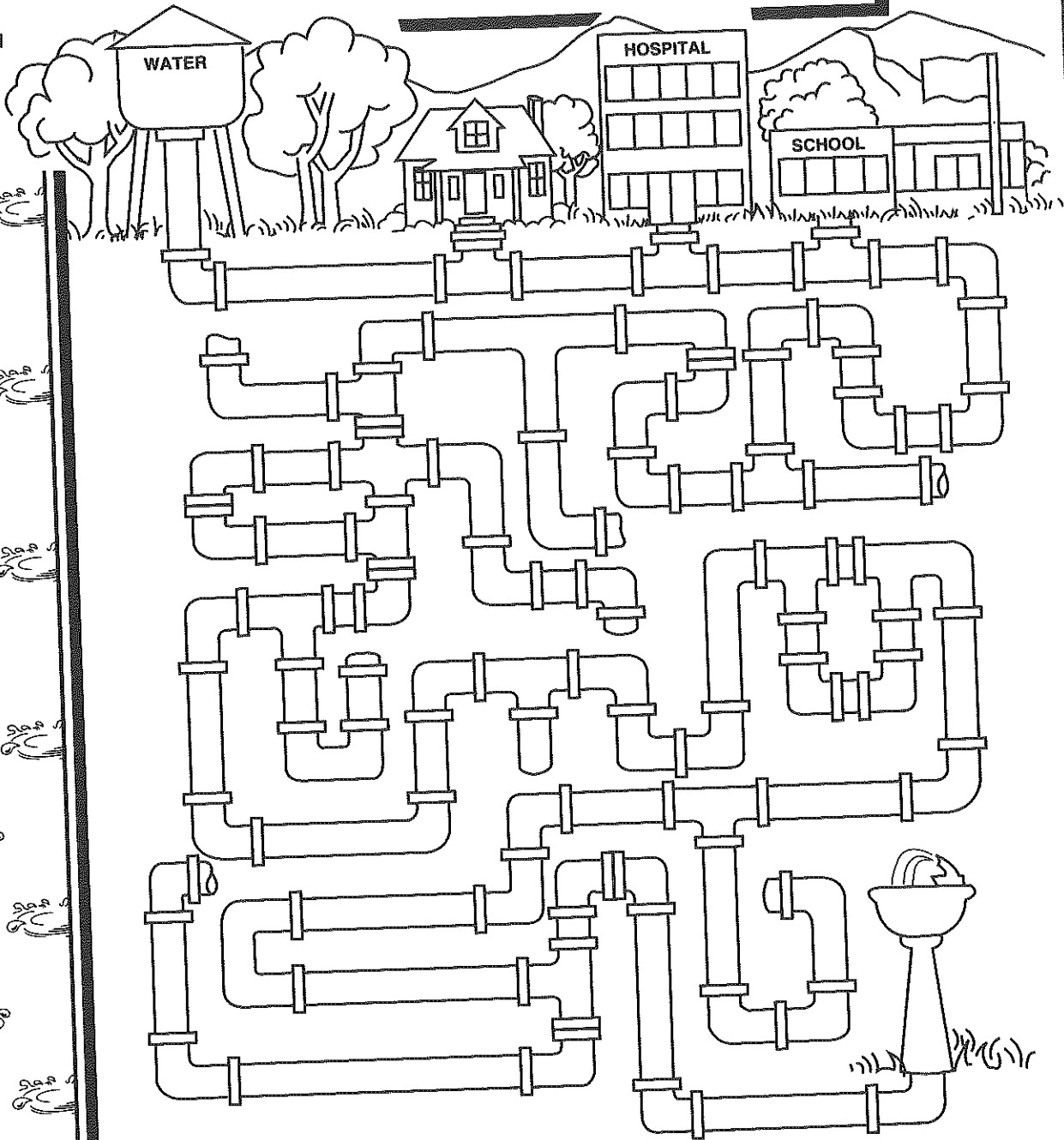


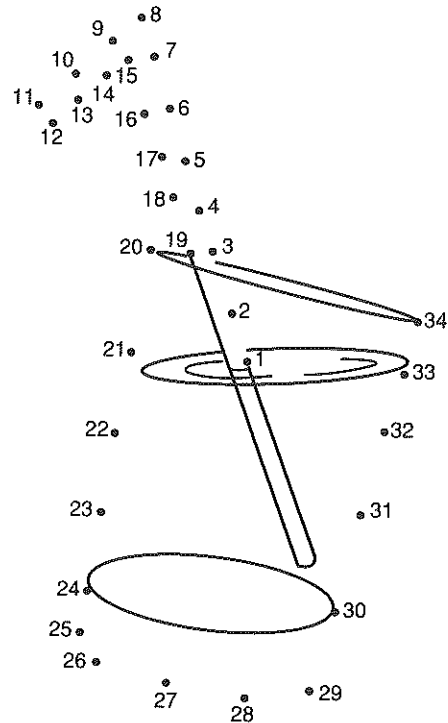

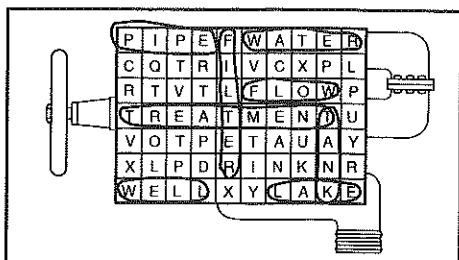
We use water from lakes and rivers. This is called surface water.
